DESCRIPTION	The Project Manager will be responsible for managing activities relating to the design and construction of solar photovoltaic (PC) power plants through to operation. Activities generally pertain to the management of the project schedule, budget, scope of work, quality control and associated reporting to GSSG Solar Japan Inc. management, lenders and investors. This entails frequent engagement with project stakeholders in coordinating project activities and resolving issues that arise to ensure the project is completed successfully. The Project Manager will join a lean renewable energy term working in the Tokyo office. Initial projects include a 47MWp plant under construction in Nagano prefecture and a 42MWp plant scheduled to start construction before end of 2017 in Fukushima prefecture. The successful candidate will demonstrate experience with project management on construction projects and an ability to interact with a broad profile of stakeholders in a facilitative manner.
ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS	The essential functions of this position are:
	 Manage and coordinate all activities pertaining to the design, construction and commissioning of a solar PV plant through to plant operation. Manage the activities of the prime construction contractor pertaining to schedule, scope of work compliance, quality management, and budget. Communicate any material variances to project schedule, scope of work, or budget to determine either corrective action or adjustment to forecasted assumptions. Address Request for Information (RFI) inquiries from project stakeholders and coordinate responses with input and guidance from Taiyo Reserve personnel. Travel to project site on a weekly basis to meet with construction contractor project management personnel and monitor project activities. Review project construction reports from construction contractor and provide project reports to Taiyo Reserve management, lender(s) and investors on a monthly basis. Support activities relating to asset management including preparation of materials for utilization requests to lenders and coordinating the schedule for payment to project vendors and contractors. Ensure compliance with all governmental authorizations and permitting documentation through coordination with the construction contractor Review quality management documentation with support from Taiyo Reserve personnel to confirm compliance with agreed specification and industry practices Facilitate interaction between multiple project stakeholders including government authorities, electric power company, contractors, land owners, technical advisor, lender agents, and other parties involved with successful project completion.
